Futureworx is a non-profit community-based organization that helps people find training employment while also supporting employers.

Workforce support

The Workplace Innovation and Productivity Skills Incentive (WIPSI) supplements employer contributions to train full-time staff (permanently located in Nova Scotia) to improve productivity and profitability, increase innovation, adapt to new technology, machinery and equipment, or work processes, increase inter-provincial and international competitiveness, and foster workplace diversity.

Graduate to Opportunity (GTO) is helping to build a stronger workforce and retain young people in Nova Scotia with a salary incentive that makes it easier to hire recent graduates. Employers receive 25% of the first year's salary — 35% if the new graduate is a member of designated diversity group — and 12.5% of the second year's salary.
